

What medical appointments and services does MOBY provide?

MOBY can help with:

- Sick visits (cough, cold, sore throat, rashes, minor injuries, pain, infections, and other general health concerns)
- Short-term medication refills until you can see your regular provider
- Pregnancy tests
- First-time birth control pill prescriptions
- HIV testing
- Dental screenings and referrals (routine care or tooth pain/infection)
- Behavioral health referrals

You can also stop by for resources, referrals, or questions about housing, insurance, food, transportation, or other New Community Clinic services without a medical appointment.

MOBY does not provide:

- Controlled substance prescriptions
- X-rays or other imaging (we can refer you if needed)
- Specialty care, such as cardiology, OB-GYN, or physical therapy (we can refer you if needed)
- Pelvic exams
- Birth control shots, implants, or IUDs
- Emergency care (we can help you decide if you should go to the Emergency Room)

If you have another concern and you're not sure if it can be addressed on MOBY, just ask!

How long will my appointment take?

Most visits take less than 30 minutes.

Who will I see?

You'll first see a registered nurse (RN) or medical assistant, then a nurse practitioner or doctor.

If you're here for a dental visit, you'll also see a dental assistant or dental hygienist and a dentist.

Will I have to wait?

Sometimes you can be seen right away. Other times, you may need to wait, depending on how many people are ahead of you. Feel free to ask about the current wait time before you register.
